PRESIDENT'S LETTER

As we begin a new year I wanted to share what the board and I have been doing.

When I was elected president in June, 2014 I promised the membership that I would personally be responsible for recruiting new leadership for the Club. I was successful due to the great people in our organization. I asked Carole Jensen to succeed Marilyn Schräder as Treasurer and she agreed. Then I asked Carole Hausmann to succeed Sue Stealey as Secretary and she agreed. Carole Jensen was in charge of the callers which seemed unfair to add that to her duties as Treasurer, so I asked Beryl Sekaran if she would take on the callers. She also agreed. Then I asked Marge Schowalter if she would like to be replaced as Luncheon Chair. She told me she had been doing it for 14 years and was very ready to step down. I asked one of our newest members. Nicole Morris, if she would take over from Marge. She also agreed. About this time, Sarah

Anderson started a new job and I could see she had a full plate. Beryl had been helping out with Ways & Means and she was able to increase her involvement. I asked Mary Schranz if she would take responsibility for the web page and she agreed. She has been investigating replacing our limited free web page with a better page for which we might have to pay a fee. Nicole agreed to be responsible for a new Facebook page (Welsh Club of Milwaukee Area).

For the April 2015 meeting I met with Alice Knickelbine and Trefor Williams about the Milwaukee Metropolitan Voices performing at Luther Manor. At that time, Trefor told me he was happy to help in any way he could. I tucked that away but thought about it as I prepared for the Memorial Service. For years, I became aware of my double handicap with regard to this service. My voice isn't strong enough to lead singing and I don't speak or sing Welsh. Several times in the past I was asked to do some verses of the hymns in Welsh. I asked Trefor to help me. I was reminded of the joke that when you put two Welshmen together you get a choir. That is a gross exaggeration! When Trefor led us in June the music was great. So I asked Trefor if he would be the Music chairperson. He agreed. Marilyn Schräder had been doing this but with her duties as Membership chair and her past strong involvement with the Club I felt she deserved a rest and this would add another new face to our leadership.

We usually hold our board meeting in August or September. I tried to organize a meeting for later in June but couldn't with everyone's schedule. We were able to schedule a meeting for July 13. I invited all the officers and committee chairs. I was pleasantly surprised that everyone attended - we had 13 in all. That included Sue Stealey and Mary Schranz who traveled long distances. We accomplished a lot in two hours but there were items we couldn't resolve at that time. One item that came up was the pressure we are experiencing with regard to the luncheon prices. So the board voted to raise the fee to \$12 per meeting starting in October.

We also discussed our financial situation. We have limited sources of revenue but have long lists of expenses. We have been liquidating the reserves we have in CDs. We can't keep doing this as we are quickly diminishing our reserves. We discussed raising the dues but realized we should have addressed this earlier and should have voted on it at the June meeting. We will be introducing an increase of the dues in October and will vote on it in December. We are proposing to raise the dues to Single-\$25 and Family-\$40. We haven't raised our dues in ten years. Everyone wants to build on our great organization but we will need a larger budget to do so.

Finally, I discovered that it appears we have never been incorporated. There are pros & cons to our incorporating, but I think the pros far outweigh the cons.

PROs

- As an unincorporated organization, each member is responsible for the Club's liabilities. Incorporation
 would protect us from that.
- As an incorporated non-profit we would be able to conduct fundraisers and solicit donations. Donations could then be deducted on the donors' tax filings.
- As a federally approved non-profit we would be able to file for WI State sales tax exemption. That would allow us to avoid paying sales taxes on the goods and services we purchase.
- We could also apply for non-profit postage rates for our mailings.

CONS

- Doing all the filings could cost us about \$400.
- It could take us months to get approval.
- We would be required to complete Articles of Incorporation.
- We would be required to complete an annual EZ form.

We will also discuss this at the October meeting.

Personally, I am excited about all we are accomplishing and impressed with the wonderful talent we have among our members and their willingness to share.
